**virginia woolf | biography, books, death, & facts ...** - virginia woolf: virginia woolf, english writer whose novels, through their nonlinear approaches to narrative, exerted a major influence on the genre. best known for her novels *mrs. dalloway* and *to the lighthouse*, she also wrote pioneering essays on artistic theory, literary history, women's writing, and the politics of power. **virginia woolf - wikipedia** - virginia woolf was born adeline virginia stephen on 25 january 1882 at 22 hyde park gate in south kensington, london to julia (née jackson) (1846–1895) and leslie stephen (1832–1904), writer, historian, essayist, biographer and mountaineer. julia jackson was born in 1846 in calcutta, bengal, british india to dr. john jackson and maria "mia" theodosia pattle, from two anglo-indian families. **virginia woolf - accelerated learning laboratory** - in 1929, virginia woolf published a collection of essays called *a room of one's own*, from which this essay is taken. in it, woolf uncovers forgotten women writers and reveals how gender affects subjects, themes, and even style. woolf begins this essay by asking questions about the lives of women in **mr. bennett and mrs. brown - columbia university** - *mr. bennett and mrs. brown* (1924) by virginia woolf it seems to me possible, perhaps desirable, that i may be the only person in this room who has committed the folly of writing, try-ing to write, or failing to write, a novel. and when i asked my-self, as your invitation to speak to you about modern fiction **who's afraid of virginia woolf?
